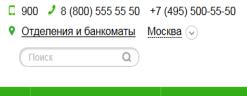


The Russian SWIFT National User and Member Group, ROSSWIFT, has been given approval by the Central Bank of the Russia Federation (CBRF) to roll out SWIFT's Know Your Customer (KYC) Registry to Russian financial institutions.

In a letter sent by the CBRF to ROSSWIFT, it explains '...Bank of Russia considers the usage of SWIFT KYC Registry database acceptable as an additional source of information if financial organizations ensure meeting the requirements of Russian legislation on AML/CFT, which include validation of the data received within identification process'.

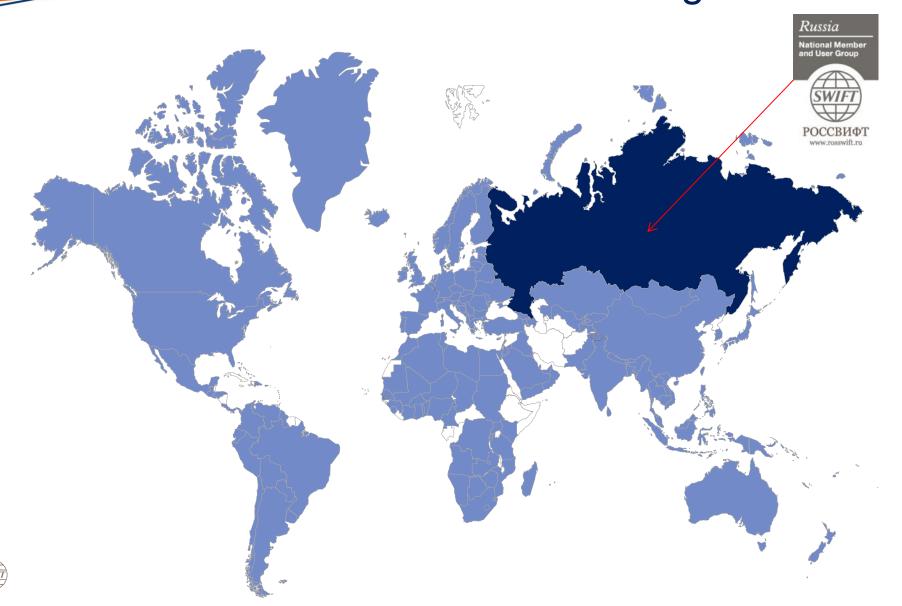


NSD Improves Procedures for Counterparty Checking Using KYC Registry

National Settlement Depository (NSD), Russia's central securities depository, announces that it has begun using the KYC Registry, a database accumulating standardized and systematized information on financial organizations from across the world, to check its counterparties and clients. The KYC Registry allows NSD (and other users) to assess information required to establish new correspondent relations and to monitor existing ones, as well as for safe data exchange with correspondent banks. Along with other sources, NSD will use KYC Registry data to check clients and to establish correspondent relations with counterparties.

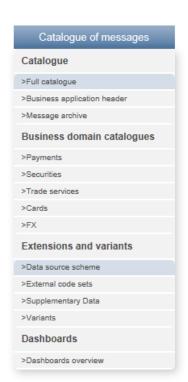


March 2016: New ISO 20022 Currency Control messages registered and published!
